On Wednesday, Oct. 12<sup>th</sup> California public schools will send home a U.S. Department of Education Federal Survey Form for parents to complete and return with your child the next day.

## Why is this important?

The amount of financial aid provided to each district is based on the number of students whose parents/guardians work on federal property, live on federal property, and/or are active duty military service members.

In order for school districts to be compensated for the revenue lost due to the presence of federally owned- and therefore tax-exempt property, or for districts that have experienced increased expenditures due to the enrollment of federally connected children, the U.S. Department of Education requires the school to survey each student to determine eligibility for such funds. Completion of the form assures the school districts received the proper amount of federal dollars, which go in to their general operating budget. The information on the surveys must be based on the parent's status as of Oct. 12, 2021

Remember the U.S.D.E. will NOT accept abbreviations or acronyms, so write out complete words, including worksites titles and addresses: and be sure to return the complete forms to school by the deadline

A FEDERAL SURVEY IS REQUIRED FROM EVERY STUDENT ENROLLED AT AKERS SCHOOL.


